HYGIENE

To ensure cleanliness and hygiene the following measures have been put in place:

- Additional cleaning of high risk areas, provided by DET. Cleaning of high-touch points during the day (e.g. door handles, chairs, tables, school playground equipment outside, switches).
- All students must **bring their own water bottle (PLEASE LABEL with CHILD'S NAME)**. Drinking taps/fountains will not be available. Students will have access to taps for refilling.
- Each classroom will have access to hand sanitiser.
- Hand sanitiser dispensers are located in various points around the school.
- Good hygiene practice will be discussed with children daily.
- Students who display any cold or flu like symptoms will be sent home.
- Students who complain of being sick will be sent home.
- We encourage families to get the all clear from a doctor following any illness.
- Encourage students to cover their mouth and nose when coughing and sneezing, or cough into their elbow.
- Dispose of tissues immediately after use and wash hands afterwards.
- Always wash hands after using the toilet and before and after eating.
- Playgrounds can be used. Children will be encouraged to practice good hand hygiene when entering back into school building from playtime.
- When providing routine care and first-aid, staff will always wash hands with soap and water or use a hand sanitiser before and after performing routine care or first aid.

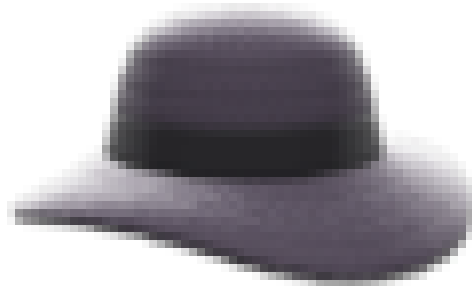
