Do I need special experience to be on school council?

No. What you do need is an interest in your child's school and the desire to work in partnership with others to help shape the school's future.

Should you be interested in becoming part of this year's School Council please see Jo for a nomination form. School Council meets eight times a year for approximately an hour and a half.

The Campbellfield Heights Primary School Council is made up of 12 members (7 parents, 3 DET employees, the Principal and a Community Representative.

To become an elected member on School Council you must nominate in either the Parent or DET employee category.

If you decide to stand for election, you can nominate yourself by completing the appropriate form. (Available on the notice board in the corridor of the main building, opposite the first aid room.

Please hand in completed nomination form to the Principal and you will receive a Nomination Form Receipt.

Generally, if there are more nominations received than there are vacancies on council, a ballot will be conducted during the two weeks after the call for nominations has closed.
