We are loving the vibe around CHPS right now. Students are engaged in their learning and so enthusiastic to come to school.

Rapid Antigen Tests (RATs) until end of term / masks 3-6

Our next delivery of RATs has arrived and will be handed to every student on Monday. Please check their bags at the end of the day. We ask that you test your child two times a week, this is because some people show no symptoms. If your child has tested positive recently, they do not need to complete any testing for 30 days. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated to keep your family and school community safe. The government has announced they will continue to supply **free RATs** until the end of term.

Masks continue to be compulsory for all students in grades 3-6 and voluntary for grades F-2.
