Free Rapid Antigen Tests (RATs) until end of term / Masks Gr 3-6

We ask that you test your child two times a week, this is because some people show no symptoms. If your child has tested positive recently, they do not need to complete any testing for 30 days. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated to keep your family and school community safe. The government has announced they will continue to supply **free RATs** until the end of term.

The latest COVID-19 School Operations Guide has been amended. If a student tests positive through a Rapid Antigen Test but does **NOT** have symptoms or has **NOT** been in contact with anyone who has COVID-19 it is recommended they get a PCR test within 48 hours and stay isolated at all times until they receive their result. If the PCR test is negative, the student can return to school.

Masks continue to be compulsory for all students in grades 3-6 and voluntary for grades F-2.
