PUPIL FREE DAY – MONDAY MAY 23rd

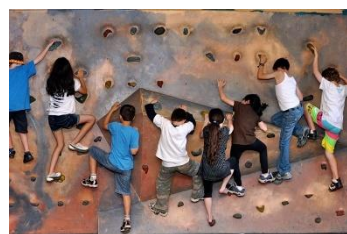
