LEAVING SCHOOL EARLY

If you need to take your child home early, please sign them out at the Office. Try and avoid taking your child home early too often as it can disrupt their learning.

ARRIVING AT SCHOOL LATE

If your child arrives at school late, they need to go the Office to collect a late pass to take to their teacher. It is important to be on time so your child doesn't miss out on important learning.

ILLNESS

Any child who is unwell should be kept home. If your child becomes ill at school, you will be called to collect him/her.

ABSENCE NOTES

All student absences are kept on record. Please phone the school or send an absent note via COMPASS when your child is going to be absent from school.

Travelling Overseas, Prior notice required – Please let the office staff members know if you are going overseas or if your child will be on extended leave from school. You are required to sign a form before leaving.

SCHOOL EXCURSIONS

During the year, your child's class will be taking part in excursions. You will receive a notice containing all the details of the excursion prior to the event. *Excursions are an important part of the school program and it is important that children participate*. After the excursion a lot of follow-up work is completed at school.

Before any child is permitted to attend an excursion, a permission form must be signed by the parent and sent to the school with payment.



MONEY AT SCHOOL

Money for school excursions should be sent in a sealed envelope with your child's name and the amount noted on the outside. Allow your child do this as it is great for their independence.



CONTACT INFORMATION

It is <u>important</u> that we can contact parents at all times. We have to know your current phone number and address. Please tell us if you change any of these details.



PERSONAL BELONGINGS

Please do NOT allow your child to bring toys to school such as electronic games and iPods, iPads or other valued items. The school takes **NO RESPONSIBILITY** for personal property (balls, bats, toys, electronic games etc) that become lost, broken or stolen at school. Students who choose to bring mobile phones to school must have them switched off and securely stored in the main office during school hours.

MEDICATION

Sometimes your child may need to take medicine at school.

Do not allow children to keep medicine or tablets in their bags.

All medicines must be handed to the office, together with instructions so that we can monitor dosage. We will give it to your child.

If your child is an asthmatic, please let us know and have your Doctor complete an Asthma Management Plan to give to the school. You must send in their Asthma Medication and Spacer.



SPECIALISTS' PROGRAMS

Your child will attend specialist programs such as Visual Arts, Performing Arts, Physical Education and Italian.



TAKE HOME BOOKS

Most days your child will choose a book to take home. Your child will choose a book that interests him or her. We ask that you spend some time-sharing the book together. This may mean -

- You read the book to your child, initially they may not be able to read it themselves
- The child "reads" the book to you using the pictures
- You talk about the book and look at the pictures
- Your child makes up his/her own story about the book
- Later your child may show you the words that he/she recognises

OTHER WORK BROUGHT HOME

Sometimes your child will bring homework that has been done at school. Please take the time to talk with them about their work. They will explain to you what it is and how they see it. Perhaps you could put it on the refrigerator or up in a special place where all the family can enjoy their efforts.

Helping your child at home

- Be positive about school
- Discuss your child's work
- Check the schoolbag for notices
- Find out who your child's friends are
- Talk about your child's day
- Show your child that you are proud of him/her.
- Take your child on outings and talk to them about where you have been.

PARENT/TEACHER INTERVIEWS and REPORTS

At Campbellfield Heights Primary School the following reporting processes will be followed:

Term 1: - Introductory Parent/Teacher Interview

Term 2: - Written Report and Parent/Teacher Interview

Term 4: - Written Report (Interview upon request of Teacher or Parent)

Parent/Teacher Interviews will be available at any time during the school year upon request by either parent or teacher.

Informal discussions are often a source of value to the teacher and the parent. Please take the opportunity to talk with your child's teacher.

However, if you have a more difficult problem or concern which you wish to discuss, it may not always be possible for the teacher to see you immediately at the time of your choice, so for this reason we ask that you make an appointment.

CAMPBELLFIELD HEIGHTS PRIMARY SCHOOL AND PARENT PARTNERSHIP

We welcome you to contact the school to make an appointment to see teachers or the Principal/Assistant Principal if you have any concerns or wish to discuss anything to do with your child's progress or social and emotional wellbeing.

At Campbellfield Heights Primary School we believe education is a partnership between the teachers and you the parents.

It is often difficult for the classroom teachers to meet with you before school as they are preparing for the day.

Book Packs Costs
